

MAINTAINING AND CARING FOR YOUR CUSTOM WORLD FURNITURE

Upon Completion of fitting your fitter will remove any protective film and will wipe the furniture down. However it is important to recognise that dust will settle so here are some guidelines for maintaining and caring for your new furniture.

Vinyl Wrapped Doors

- Looking after Vinyl finish furniture could not be simpler. Wipe the surface of the doors with a soft cloth we recommend a microfibre cloth with a mild non-abrasive detergent diluted in water. The mix should be 1 part detergent to 99 parts warm water.
- Do not use any vinegar-based detergents, solvents, abrasive detergents, white spirit or furniture polish.

Mirrored Doors

A watered down solution of white vinegar and water will get rid of smears on mirrored doors. However it is important to ensure that cleaning products are not sprayed directly on to the mirror as there is a risk that the cleaning product may gain access to the mirror backing through the edges and seams, which can cause damage.

High Gloss Doors (Lacquered and Foil wrapped)

- Do not clean your doors or drawer fronts for the first 72 hours after installation.
- To clean high gloss wardrobe doors use a wet cloth with mild soap and water. Use only a clean, microfibre cloth, chamois or other very soft cloth.
- Do not use paper towels, brushes, scourers or scrapers.
- Never dry wipe.
- Avoid using any cleaning products which are, or contain: Alcohol based, solvent based, abrasive cleaners, acetone, petrol, glass cleaner, pinewood or oils. These chemicals will damage the High Gloss surface.





Running Tracks for Sliding Doors

- Keep the bottom track clear of dust, debris and pet hairs by using the thin nozzle on your vacuum cleaner to keep the tracks free. This will ensure your sliding wardrobe doors continue to operate smoothly.
- Keep liquids and cleaning products away from the running tracks as this may cause corrosion and deterioration over time.
- Use a damp cloth, not wet, to remove excess dirt and dust from the top tracks.
- A small amount of silicone spray can be used on the tracks just to maintain easy glide.

Drawers

Drawer runners need to be kept dust and grit free by vacuuming or brushing periodically. No oiling is required.

Hinges for Hinged Doors

Hinges are maintenance free and require no oiling, minor adjustments may be required from time to time.

Internal Shelves

- Care **MUST** be taken when stocking shelves as overloading shelves will cause damage to the unit. Internal shelving and storage solutions can be cleaned with a slightly damp microfibre cloth.
- Excessive moisture can damage the finish. Do not spray cleaner directly on to the surface or allow moisture to seep into seams or joints. Do not leave damp cloths draped over shelves or wardrobe doors or drawer fronts.
